3. *Coach & Player Development*
 - a. *Reviewed check-in process and went over how to make things easier*
 - b. *Tryout schedule to be published in Sandwich Enterprise for next 2 weeks & on website*
 - c. *Players cannot play on Maple & Town club U-15 and older due to Mass Youth Soccer rules.*
 - d. *If unable to make scheduled tryout:*
 1. *Must notify by e-mail or phone call ahead of time to Steve Hopkins*
 2. *Need to tryout with age group above & special attention will be given to player to get fair evaluations.*
 - e. *1 v 1's scoring system: win 6 points, loss 0 points and tie 3 points-10 games*
 - f. *4 v 4 scoring system: win 4 points, loss 0 points and tie 2 points-8 games with evaluations being done on players as they are playing*
 - g. *11 v 11 or 8 v 8 depending on #'s have evaluators assessing the player*
 - h. *After talking w/coaches and parents who wanted to put less emphasis on 1 v 1's & 4 v 4's numbers and more emphasis on evaluations and comments from evaluators*

 - i. *Discussion about all decisions and discussions regarding Board matters to be*
