



Sandwich Soccer Club Performance Bond Policy



The Sandwich Soccer Club (SSC) strives to provide a competitive, challenging and affordable travel soccer program for the community. In order to do that and keep our costs down, we need to implement a Performance Bond, as many other sport programs in the area have done. We have found that the same parents volunteer over and over, and in order to keep the program vibrant, we need to spread the load either through increased volunteer participation or paid services. Therefore, in addition to registration fees the SSC is requiring a \$150.00 per family performance bond or 3 hours of work for the program during the season.

We want to be clear: **WE DON'T WANT YOUR MONEY; WE WANT YOUR PARTICIPATION.** A detailed list of volunteer opportunities will be available at registration night or you may view the list below. Your performance bond check will be post dated for June 1 of the current season year and will be collected on registration night. If you choose to opt out (not volunteer) the SSC will cash your \$150 check at the beginning of the season. Conversely, by agreeing to volunteer 3 hours, in any of the possible capacities, from any family member your \$150 performance post dated check will be held until which time the volunteer hours are completed and signed off by the coach or a board member. All volunteer sign- up sheets and hours will be confirmed. Once verified, the club will return or destroy the checks at the end of the season.

This is not meant to be a hardship or barrier to participation. We understand that every family faces unique challenges and if this commitment is a concern, please contact the current SSC VP of Operations/Volunteer Coordinator on our website operations@sandwichsoccer.org. NO child will be denied access to the soccer program because of this performance bond. However, it is our goal to increase parental involvement in our soccer program.
